Event concept

In our Afro-Cuban workshops in Havana, we seek to offer an authentic learning environment similar to that experienced by professional dancers training in Cuba - participants can develop a better understanding of both Afro-Cuban music and dances. Also we wish to maintain understanding about Cuban popular dances like Danzon, Son, Mambo or Salsa through our meeting

Main objectives

To give dance enthusiasts the opportunity to be taught by professional dancers and teachers in Cuba and discover and/or understand the roots of Afro-Cuban & popular Cuban social dances and traditions

To enable participants to make fast progress (whatever their level) in an intensive course taught by highly qualified and experienced teachers

To give the opportunity to Cuban professional artists, teachers and musicians who cannot leave the country easily to share their knowledge and experience of their life within this music and dance culture

To enable participants to discover and enjoy Cuban culture and practice what they have learnt in the workshops in a variety of venues in the Cuban capital

To keep Cuban dance and music traditions and heritage alive in and outside of Cuba – and pass them on

Luanda danced as a soloist with the National Folkloric Ballet of Cuba for 8 years. With 19 years of experience as a teacher, dancer and choreographer, she has participated in numerous festivals and artistic events in Cuba, Europe, America and Africa, she is still just as passionate about her culture and continues to develop a variety of projects to maintain a high level of understanding and delivery.

Currently based in London, Luanda organizes and teaches a great variety of master classes, workshops; she also organizes and participates in a number of UK and international events with the aim to increase sensitivity to and understanding of Afro-Cuban culture and heritage outside of Cuba. In the future, she is hoping to open a Cuban dance academy for adults and children.

Classes are overseen by Master Domingo Pau. Musicians, teachers and assistants have been selected for their high standard of professionalism and for their extended knowledge. Several of them have over 50 years of professional experience in Afro-Cuban dance & music.

You can secure your place by paying a (non-refundable) £100 deposit and pay the rest before December 31, 2019

It is our responsibility to provide the workshops you have signed for and make all the arrangements for the social events which are part of the programme. We can - and will - provide assistance outside of the course but it is not our duty. **We are not responsible for flights, travel insurance or accommodation.**

We reserve the right to alter slightly the class programme.

By registering for this course participants grant permission to be filmed, recorded or photographed; they may appear on material then used for marketing or promotional purposes without compensation.

Timekeeping will be crucial and we will expect participants to arrive on time and ready to start the workshops straight away.

Filming classes is prohibited – however, you will have the opportunity to film your teachers performing the steps, moves and sequences taught in each class at the end of each workshop.

All participants will need - and are responsible for getting - **adequate travel insurance** so as to be fully covered in the event of an accident. Do check carefully what is covered by your insurance and, if you have any concerns, speak to your insurance company prior to travel. Make sure you get an insurance that provides emergency travel and medical assistance abroad, and check whether the planned activities or any medical condition you may have affect cover. In the event of an accident or if you get ill whilst on our course in Cuba, please make sure you let the organisers know straight away so they can help you with any immediate required assistance. You will be given a list of contacts and phone numbers closer to the departure date.

If you need to cancel your holiday due to an emergency or health reasons, the cancellation fee will depend on the date of cancellation:

Deposit: non-refundable

Up to 90 days before trip: 75% refund

90-60 days before trip: 50%

60-30 days before trip: 30% refund

1-30 days before trip: no refund

Alternatively, you may also transfer your holiday to someone else. If you wish to do so, please contact Luanda Pau directly.
